Lab # 3 Charged Matter

Purpose: To observe evidence that charged particles are part of matter.

Hypothesis: If I hold the tape with like charges near each other the one piece of tape will repel from the other.

Materials: Tape, drawing paper

Procedure:

- 1. Obtain two pieces of plastic tape about six inches long.
- 2. Fold over a half inch of each piece to form a nonsticky handle.
- 3. Stick the two strips smoothly to your desktop.
- 4. Pull up both tapes simultaneously and slowly move the nonsticky sides of the tapes toward each other.
- 5. Do not allow the tapes to touch each other.

Data:

- 1. Observe what happens
- 2. Draw two pictures showing how the tape moves
